- **Is there ever a duty in tort to ensure that someone else is insured?**
Nick Heathcote Williams QC will chart the continuing developments in this area which stretches from professional negligence through compulsory motor and employer's liability insurance to occupier's liability and ordinary common negligence, via insurance broking, an unwisely lent car, a mangled hand, accidents in Ethiopia and on the rugby field, a splat wall and encounters with chaos and a bouncer. Chambers UK (2007) hails Nick for doing "a sterling job every time".
- **Motor insurance – RTA Article 75 or MIB central fund – who pays?**
Stephen Worthington QC will address the inter-relationship between Section 151 RTA 1988, Article 75 and MIB central funds. Stephen is well known for his MIB work and his ability to manage client expectations – "they seem to accept advice from Stephen that they wouldn't accept from anyone else" (Legal 500 2006).
- **Cost-Capping**
Simon Levene will look at the topical issue of cost-capping, answering the following questions. When it is appropriate to apply for a cost-capping order? What evidence will you need? What are the principles on which the Court will make such an order? Simon "combines a good sense of humour" (Legal 500 2006) with over 20 years experience in the field of Personal Injury. He has a particular interest in cases involving accountancy evidence and complex schedules.
