Frank Burton QC and Harry Steinberg were leading and junior counsel for 3 of the claimants in the case of Johnston -v- NEI International Combustion Ltd. In this case the House of Lords decided the claimants, who were suffering from Pleural Plaques, could not recover damages from the person who had exposed them to asbestos, even if they were suffering from psychiatric illness caused by the exposure.

Frank Burton QC and Harry Steinberg will review the future of asbestos litigation following this decision and discuss which types of claim survive notwithstanding the decision and which do not.
