

Improving the case management of the non-compliant client in severe brain injury cases

Topics

This seminar will give you useful updates and guidance in respect of the following:

- **The non-compliant client**
Gerard Martin is a “claimant only” silk specialising in brain injury litigation. His talk will focus on how to improve case management by the claimant’s legal team of this complex type of litigant so as to maximise the client’s potential for a better outcome. This session will include discussion of the early involvement of both neuropsychologists and receivers, the MCA 2005 and the new Code of Practice.
- **Brain injury problems and non compliance**
Dr Camilla Herbert, Consultant Clinical Neuropsychologist at the Brain Injury Rehabilitation Trust (BIRT) will focus on brain injury problems that relate to non compliance - lack of awareness, memory, motivation, problems of aggression and disinhibition. She will explore how they impact on care plans and lawyers’ case management and advise on how to minimise that impact.
- **Practical aspects of case management with the non-compliant client**
Jo Clark-Wilson, Managing Director at Headfirst will examine the practical aspects of case management with the non-compliant client. She will explore the factors involved in clients’ presentation, families and friends, rehabilitation programmes and environmental aspects and will consider the risk impacting on management care and support in the community.
