Insurance

Emily is frequently instructed to advise, plead for and represent parties in cases involving fraud and dishonesty in the criminal, civil and tribunal context and has successfully obtained and deflected many findings of fraud and dishonesty in the County Court as well as the Employment Tribunal. Her robust cross examination, where appropriate, is something Judges, clients and other parties often complement her on.

Inquests

Emily had attended inquests all over the Country over the past 15 years; involving sporting accidents, particularly accidents involving horses and dealing with the safety of the animals, protective clothing and sporting courses, enquiries into questions of clinical practice and fatal accidents including road traffic accidents and matters where there have been multiple fatalities. Emily attended the criminal trial at Bristol Crown Court on behalf of insurance companies interested in the M5 black fog crash in 2011.

This is an area that is part of her clinical negligence and personal injury practices where fatal incidents are involved and she has represented families as well as insured interests and is very able to offer her professional advice and assistance in the Coroners' Court. Emily is fully up to date with the relevant rules, practices and procedures that apply in this Court.

Credit Hire

Emily has lectured on Credit Hire at the annual PIBA conference for barristers in Oxford and regularly deals with credit hire disputes both at first instance and on appeal as a longstanding part of her RTA practice. Emily is very knowledgeable and up to date in this hotly contested area of law.

Product Liability

Within her personal injury, insurance and general civil practice, particularly in property related matters, Emily is regularly involved in product liability disputes involving anything from medical implants and kitchen appliances to sewerage tanks and is happy to act and advise in the same.

Discrimination

Emily has many years of experience in Employment Law, which she ceased in 2017 to focus on her core civil practice areas but incidental to this she has a good understanding of the provisions of the Equality Act 2010. Many of the employment cases involved some form of psychiatric harm as a result of discrimination or harassment, such as a Claimant becoming so anxious and depressed that he could no longer work having previously worked at the executive level in a huge multinational logistics firm. Discrimination law is something that Emily continues to indulge in, albeit now in the context of civil claims.

Property & Land

Emily worked for a property developer and in-house for a firm of solicitors dealing with property related claims, in particular professional indemnity claims against property professionals, including fraud allegations. Emily continues to accept instructions in public liability, professional negligence, construction and property insurance cases including policy coverage, boundary disputes, neighbour disputes, harassment, nuisance, negligence causing damage to property, trespass and Rylands v Fletcher. Many of the cases undertaken over the past 4 years involve fire/explosive material, oil, asbestos contamination, sewerage related nuisance, disputes over easements and other neighbourly discord.

Emily also advises on contractual and statutory disputes relating to construction works and for or against utilities providers.

As a registered legal aid provider Emily has also acted in other property related disputes, obtaining High Court injunctive relief, acting in disputes as to equitable interests in homes and housing cases.

International & Travel

This is an area of law that Emily has some familiarity with and is currently developing.

Emily has acted in mediations in both civil and employment cases and intends to qualify as a mediator.

Emily has undertaken a number of cases involving insolvency and bankruptcy law as well as restoring companies to the register and is happy to be instructed in cases involving these issues.
