

Covid-19: Visitor Guidance

We expect all visitors to 12KBW to follow Government guidance in respect of Covid-19. In addition, all visitors must read and comply with the guidance below.

Before your visit

In advance of your visit you will be asked to confirm whether you fall into any of the following categories:

- You have tested positive for Covid-19 in the last 10 days;
- You have experienced any flu-like and/or Covid-19 symptoms in the last 10 days;
- You have been in close contact with anyone experiencing any flu-like and/or Covid-19 symptoms in the last 14 days;
- You have been told to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace in the last 14 days;
- You have returned from a country which is not exempt from quarantine requirements in the last 14 days.

If you fall into any of these categories, you must not visit 12KBW and we will make arrangements for your meeting to take place remotely or at a later date.

If you are clinically extremely vulnerable, or if you are caring for someone who is clinically extremely vulnerable, we recommend that your visit should take place remotely.

During your visit

We ask you to take the following steps during your visit:

- Use the hand sanitiser gel in the entrance way as you enter the building;
- Follow the one-way system and entrance and exit signs;
- Observe social distancing;
- Use the hand sanitiser gel in meeting rooms;
- Follow good hand washing hygiene.
